Approve Minutes: Mayor Owens made a motion to accept the regular meeting minutes from June 5, 2023, as written. Seconded by Councilwoman Hayes. 4 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried. Meeting from June 20, 2023, was cancelled due to lack of quorum.

1. Town of Jay Report:

Livestock Ordinance: Mr. Seib will have the final draft to present at the next meeting for first reading of the revised ordinance.

3. New Business:

Adams Sanitation Update: Mr. Seib stated that Nathan Boyles of Adams Sanitation had contacted him regarding the contract that Adams has obtained with the City of Crestview. Adams is looking to partner with a company in order to handle the addition of Crestview and to continue its service with other contracts that they currently have. Due to the contract that the Town of Jay has with Adams Sanitation, they must have approval from the Town to move forward with this merger. Councilwoman Hayes made a motion based on the recommendation by Adams that pursuant to the exclusive franchise for residential and commercial solid waste collection and disposal by and between Adams Sanitation Holding Company, LLC and dated October 05, 2020, the Council hereby consents to the transfer of beneficial membership interests or stock interests in franchisee of not more than 80%. This is scheduled to occur on or about July 15, 2023. Franchisee shall provide the Town of Jay with written confirmation of the completion of the transaction no later than August 15, 2023. This approval shall be rescinded if written confirmation is not provided on or before August 15, 2023. Nothing herein shall authorize an assignment of the Franchisee's rights pursuant to the Franchise Agreement. Seconded by Councilman Holloway. 4 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Community Center Electronic Sign Options: This was discussed during the workshop and Mr. Tiller will present options at a later date.




4. Visitor Comments: None
