Regular Council Meeting Minutes April 18, 2022

Meeting Call to Order: Eric Seib

Approve Minutes: Mayor Owens made a motion to accept the previous regular council meeting minutes as written. Seconded by Councilwoman Hendricks. 3 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

1. Town of Jay Report:

Engineering Report: Ms. Weatherington gave the engineering report. The USDA water line project is currently finishing up on Bob Sikes. The fence around the fitness center was discussed. Mayor Owens stated that he may have some top rail and components that could be utilized. Donation levels for the park project were discussed.

Operations Report: Mr. Seib presented the operations report (attached). The gas line extension was discussed. Resolution No. 22-05-01 was presented regarding securing the loan for the Gas line extension. Mayor Owens made a motion to accept RESOLUTION NO. 22-05-01. A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF JAY, FLORIDA SECURING A LOAN FOR UP TO \$6000,000 FOR NATURAL GAS LINE EXTENSION. Seconded by councilwoman Hendricks. 3 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried. Mr. Cozart is working on the title search for State Street.

2. Old Business:

Land Development Code Review: Mr. Seib stated that a public workshop will need to be held. The grant deadline is June 30, 2022.

American Legion Lease: Mayor Owens and Mr. Seib met with representatives for the American Legion. Mayor Owens requested the cost for adding the 290' field to the park renovation. The cost would be around \$400,000 according to Ms. Weatherington. Discussion followed. Councilman Holloway made a motion to reject the proposal to include the 290' field on the American Legion property. Seconded by Mayor Owens. 2 yeas (Holloway, Owens), 1 nay (Hendricks). Motion carried.

Cost of Living Wage Discussion: Councilwoman Hayes was not able to attend the meeting, so this is tabled until the next regular meeting.

3. New Business:

American Rescue Act: This funding could be used on Well #4. Ms. Weatherington will send contact information to Mr. Seib regarding reporting forms. We must state by April 30, 2022, what we will spend the money on. Overages could be used for the replacement of the current water lines. Councilman Holloway asked for pros and cons of spending the money on Well #4 versus the Sewer lines. Discussion followed.

Jay Pro Rodeo: Frederick Barrow was present to request the Town's support for the 21st annual Jay Pro Rodeo. He asked for use of the town's portable bleachers. Mr. Seib stated that the town budgets money for the school each August. The town gave \$1600 to Jay High School Athletic Department in 2021. These funds were to be allocated to the sports at Jay. Mayor Owens requested financial reports for the rodeo for the last few years. Mr. Barrow stated that these could be requested from Lana Rowell, Jay High School SGA sponsor. Mayor Owens made a motion to give \$500 to the Jay Pro Rodeo. Seconded by Councilwoman Hendricks. 3 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Dollar General Sign Approval: (attached). The new Dollar General store requested a letter of approval for the sign that they will be putting up. Mayor Owens made a motion to accept the proposed sign as shown. Seconded by Councilman Holloway. 3 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried. Mr. Seib will prepare the letter and submit to the Dollar General representatives.

4. Visitor Comments: None.

Mayor Owens made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Councilman Holloway. 3 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

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RESOLUTION NO. 22-04-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF JAY, FLORIDA SECURING A LOAN FOR UP TO \$600,000 FOR NATURAL GAS LINE EXTENSION.

THE TOWN OF JAY DOES RESOLVE:

That the Town of Jay would like to secure a loan for up to \$600,000.00 to be secured by a General Obligation Warrant to fund the extension of the Town's Natural Gas service line, and RESOLVED that, it is within the Authority of the Town to incur debt.

RESOLVED that, the town establish a Bank Qualified Loan at United Bank for the amount of up to \$600,000.00 with a pre-approved interest rate of 2.875% fixed interest rate, for a term of 30 years.

RESOLVED that, the Town of Jay is a qualified Tax-Exempt Municipality and the interest paid under this indebtedness will be considered tax exempt to the holder.

RESOLVED that, repayment will be monthly interest only payments for one year, followed by monthly principal and interest payments for 29 years.

RESOLVED that, the Town Council authorizes the Mayor to execute such documents, instruments and contracts as he may determine, in his discretion, to be necessary or desirable in connection with the loan.

SO RESOLVED, this 18th day of April, 2022.

ON MOTION of Mayor Shon Owens seconded by Councilwoman Nina Hendricks, the above Resolution was introduced and passed by the UAO.
